

RING SIZING GUIDE

HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

Before proceeding ensure that this page printed correctly by measuring the scale on the right.

For best results measure your finger when it's at its largest which is usually at the end of the day. Avoid measuring your finger when your hands are cold. Cold temperatures cause your fingers to shrink slightly.

Keep in mind that rings over 5mm in width may fit more snugly than narrower widths.

CONFIRM PRINTED PAPER SIZE

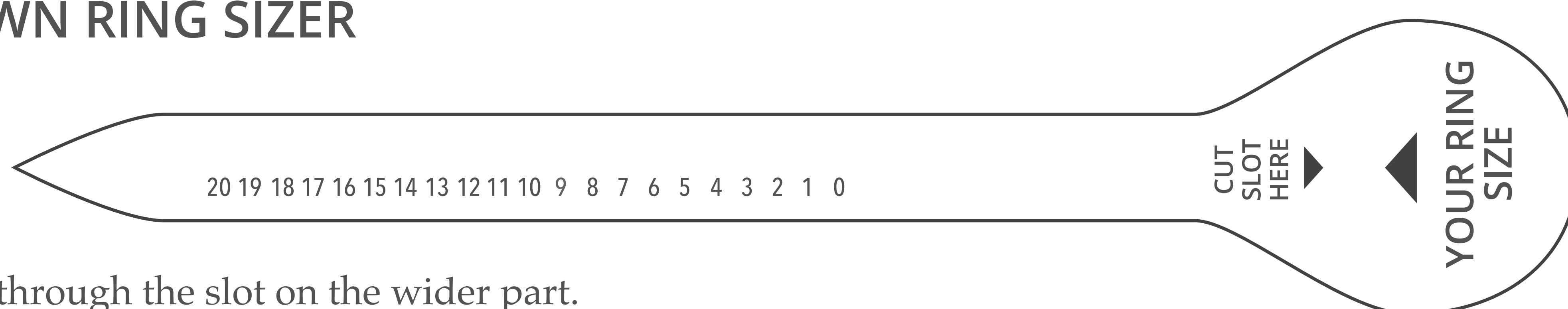

Print this page on standard US Letter paper. Set the page fit option to 100%.

Measure the above scale to ensure that it is exactly two inches. If the measurement is not exact, rings size measurement will not be completed properly.

OPTION 1: CREATE YOUR OWN RING SIZER

1. Cut out the rings sizer.
2. Wrap the ring sizer snugly around your finger and insert the pointed end through the slot on the wider part.
3. The number indicated through the slot is your ring size.



OPTION 1: MEASURE A CURRENT RING

1. Find a ring that correctly fits your intended finger.
2. Place your ring on each of the circles below until you find one that closely matches the inside diameter of your ring.
3. If the ring fits between two sizes order a quarter size in between.
